The department shall also investigate, under Subchapter F, Chapter 48, Human Resources Code, a report of abuse, neglect, or exploitation of a child receiving services from an officer, employee, agent, contractor, or subcontractor of a home and community support services agency licensed under Chapter 142, Health and Safety Code, if the officer, employee, agent, contractor, or subcontractor is or may be the person alleged to have committed the abuse, neglect, or exploitation.

More than a third of adolescents with a report of abuse or neglect will have a substance use disorder before their 18th birthday, three times as likely as those without a report of abuse or neglect. 14; 11.5% of children have a parent/caregiver alcohol abuse risk factor. 1; 28.5% of children have a parent/caregiver drug abuse risk factor. 1

Child abuse and neglect. Abuse, neglect, self-neglect, and exploitation of the elderly or adults with disabilities living at home. Abuse of children in child-care facilities or treatment centers. Abuse of adults and children who live in state facilities or are being helped by programs for people with mental illness or intellectual disabilities.

DFPS - Report Abuse or Neglect

Mental mistreatment or emotional abuse is deliberately causing mental or emotional pain. Examples include intimidation, coercion, ridiculing, harassment, treating an adult like a child, isolating an adult from family, friends, or regular activity, use of silence to control behavior, and yelling or swearing which results in mental distress.

Your Abuse and Neglect Court Case You are in court because a complaint about your child's care has been filed in the Family Court. The complaint asks the court to decide if your child has been neglected and/or abused and who will have custody of your child. Your case is a child neglect case.
