This is despite the inscription of 1507 on the stonework "Hoc Opus constructum est anno Domini millesimo Quingentesimo decimo septimo," - a matter of ongoing dispute between historians.

The first things a visitor is likely to see on entering the cathedral are the stoup and the statue of the Welcoming Christ high on the facing pillar. Christ appears with opened widespread arms of welcome. It was erected in 1971 to mark (a year late!) the 800 year anniversary of the death of Thomas Becket. The work was by a local sculptor, William Cyril Day, and the carving is in the wood afrormosia.

The City Gates of Canterbury

The Christ Church Gate serves as the main visitor entrance to Canterbury Cathedral's grounds.
