be necessary to designate and establish the highway as a freeway. This action is initiated after the design of the freeway is approved and once approval is received on environmental reports. When establishing a freeway, the district will need to prepare an Order Establishing a Freeway; see Chapter 12.

Rural and Urban Freeways - Illinois Department of ...

In 2018, the rate of crash deaths per 100 million miles traveled was 2 times higher in rural areas than in urban areas (1.68 in rural areas compared with 0.86 in urban areas). From 1977 to

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2018, the rate decreased by 61 percent in rural areas (from 4.35 to 1.68) and 63 percent in urban areas (from 2.35 to 0.86).

Urban/rural comparison - IIHS-HLDI

Most highway mileage is located in rural areas - more than 3.0 million miles. But these roads carry only 30 percent of highway traffic. Most traffic is in urban areas, resulting in greater wear and tear on urban roads and bridges and congested travel conditions.

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
