Medicare Coverage of Physical Exams—Know the Differences

You can do this by performing the once-in-a-lifetime wellness visit known as the Initial Preventive Physical Examination (IPPE).1 Members are eligible for the IPPE during the first 12 months of enrollment in Medicare. After 12 months, members may receive either the initial once-in-a-lifetime Annual Wellness Visit (AWV)2 or if already performed, the

Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance) for longer than 12 months, you can get a yearly “Wellness” visit once every 12 months to develop or update a personalized prevention plan to help prevent disease and disability, based on your current health and risk factors. Your provider may also perform a cognitive impairment assessment.

Your Medicare Annual Wellness exam serves as a regular follow-up to assess any changes in your health over the previous year and track the progress of your personalized prevention plan. You will be asked to fill out a “ Health Risk Assessment ,” which includes a series of questions about your health, diet and lifestyle.

The Annual Wellness Visit Guide includes a wellness visit checklist and information on: Medicare coverage for wellness visits. Correct coding for wellness visits. Guidance to help ensure all member conditions are correctly coded each year. Coding for other evaluation and management services, such as lab tests.

A person is eligible for an initial physical examination within the first 12 months of Medicare enrollment. After that time, they are eligible for an annual wellness visit once every 12 months ...

Medicare: Annual physical vs. Annual Wellness Visit

G0402 is the “Welcome to Medicare Exam” which is basically a routine physical which can only be done in the first 12 months the patient becomes eligible for Medicare. G0438 is the code for the first, initial, Annual Wellness Visit.

Medicare preventive services include lab tests, exams, screenings, and shots. Health monitoring programs, training, and counseling also have coverage. Your doctor reviews services during the “Welcome to Medicare” and Annual Wellness Visits. The Medicare preventive service checklist helps you track the services you complete and tests you need.

Check your height, weight, blood pressure, and other routine measurements. Give you a health risk assessment. This may include a questionnaire that you complete before or during the visit. The questionnaire asks about your health status, injury risks, behavioral risks, and urgent health needs.

The Initial Preventive Physical Examination (IPPE) is also known as the “Welcome to Medicare Preventive Visit.” The IPPE is a preventive visit offered to newly-enrolled Medicare beneficiaries.

Initial Preventive Physical Examination (IPPE)

Medicare never pays for routine or annual exams in the 99xxx code range. This is clear in all the information that is given about IPPE and AWV. Medicare only pays for problem-oriented visits and approved preventive services. It is inappropriate to have the patient sign an ABN in these cases.

Because of this, Medicare Advantage plans do provide the same Part A and Part B coverage as Original Medicare, including wellness visits. Although Medicare Part C providers must follow Original Medicare guidelines at a minimum, many Medicare Advantage plans provide additional benefits. The annual wellness visit generally doesn't include a physical exam, except to check routine measurements such as height, weight and blood pressure.
